

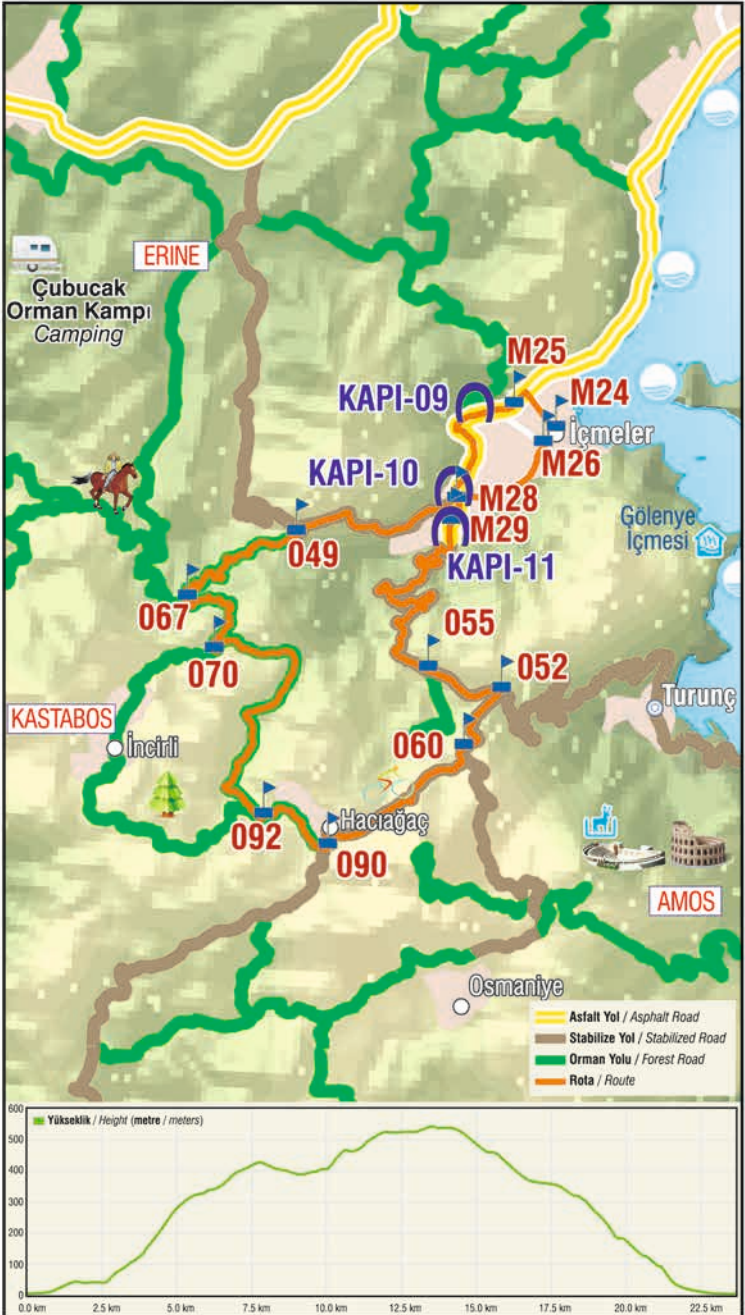

"The Higher You Get, The Better The View"

Turunç (bitter orange) is a small resort that takes its name from the citrus fruits that are grown all over the village. It is a charming resort town below the lush green slopes of the mountains.

There are plenty of alternatives for accommodation. Diving enthusiasts prefer the aquarium-like coves, hiking lovers enjoy the paths in the mountains.



ROUTE 11

Turunç-Bayır-Kızılcaöğretmen-Camiyanı-Kumlubük-Turunç

The first kilometers of the tour are tough. While you climb up the hill, you will forget your tiredness with the amazing view of the coastal area.

The first stop is in Bayır; this authentic village is different from the other tourist locations.

Enjoy drinking a tea under the 2000 years old maple tree and fill your bottles with spring water from the historical fountain.





The road through the pine forests leads to *Kumlubük bay*. You will find few fountains on the way down the hill.

The view from green covered slopes down to the deep blue waters is worth the fatigue.

Amos, one of the most important Carians settlements, is few kilometers from Turunç. The site of Amos is situated on a hill controlling both the land and sea passages.

The view from the top is simply amazing.

There are many coves which can only be reached by boat: these places are perfect for swimming.

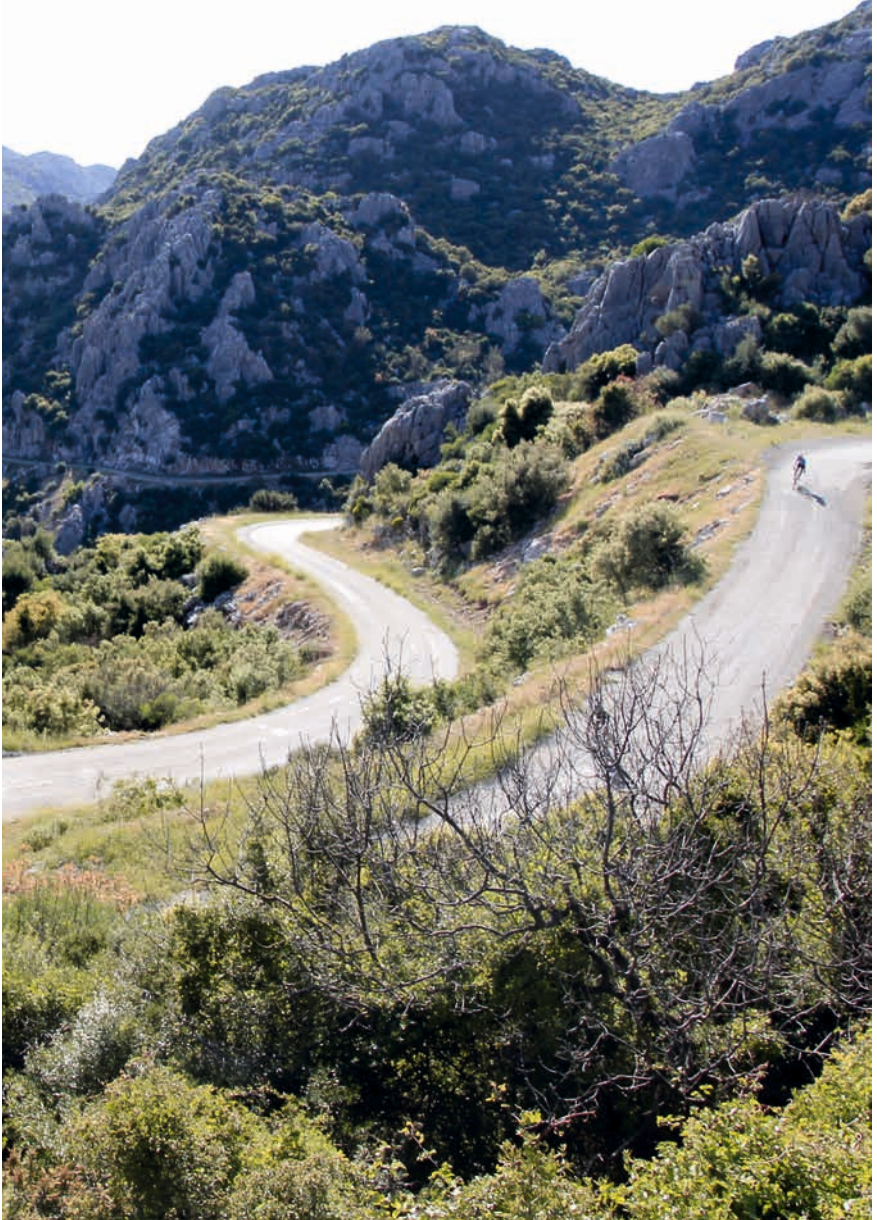

Bozburun-Avlana-Selimiye-Söğüt-Bozburun



“Panoramic Cycling”

This circular route is on mainly asphalt paths. Flat stretches alternate with hilly sections, most of which are manageable even for the less trained.

Amazing views, friendly people, and delicious food make cycling a great pleasure in this part of [Bozburun peninsula](#).

Bozburun is the main town of Bozburun peninsula. The small settlement is spread out around the shore.

Bozburun is famous for building the traditional wooden boats called gulet.



ROUTE 12

Bozburun-Avlana-Selimiye-Söğüt-Bozburun

You might find yourself starrng for a while at the carpenters building these wooden giants of the sea in open air workshops.

There are many small hotels and pensions stretching along the seafront as well as a variety of restaurants serving freshly caught fish.

Leaving Bozburun, look back to the wonderful view of the bay and reach the valley to Avlana Mahallesi.

The asphalt road to Selimiye is the alternative to the challenging dirt road up the hill.

Again the magical views over limestone peaks and down to the sheltered inlet will let you forget your tired legs.



Enter the village of Selimiye and cycle through the almond and olive grove gardens.

The *Selimiye-Söğüt* leg of the tour is quite hilly.

The ruins of the *Thyssanos* settlement in southwestern part of Söğüt consist of just a few pieces of walls and traces of their foundations.



Excavation works have not been done yet; hence there is little information available about this settlement.

In Söğüt you can supply your needs and continue to Bozburun. Cycling down to *Cumhuriyet Mahallesi* (formerly *Saranda*) and visiting this relaxing resort is also an option.

ROUTE 12

Bozburun-Avlana-Selimiye-Söğüt-Bozburun



There are very good restaurants with delicious dishes. The road to Bozburun has little traffic and cycling is a great pleasure.

Highlights: traditional boat building, fantastic coastal views, stone houses in Söğüt, ruins of Thynassos, carob and sweet gum trees
